Week 5 – Walking with Jesus and the Spirit

A chief relationship we must foster and grow is our relationship with Jesus and the Spirit. But how do we do that? What are some tools we can use to draw close to God? How do we renew our minds and keep focused on Jesus in a world full of distractions?

Week 6 – Walking in Unity and Fellowship

The world is full of division and hate. But you expect that from the world. The problem is that we face division in the Church. What does the Bible say about unity and fellowship with other believers? Is there a situation in which we must allow division or separate from other believers? How do you deal with false doctrines and false teachers?

Week 7 – Walking with the Family of God Part 1

How do we deal with sin in the Church? What are some other expectations on us? We will focus on Jesus's teachings in the Gospels and the book of Acts.
